The East Branch Assembly campaigned to reinstate a local bus service that had been re routed. Now around 60 older people have access to a bus service that they thought they had lost for good.

The groups have invited guest speakers from many different agencies and organisations, These have included Age UK, Community Health Team, NHS, Nexus, Gateshead LINk to name a few. But it's not just about discussing issues, there is fun to be had as well. Our groups have had tea dances, coach trips, (these include Eden Camp, Beamish, Bowes Museum and Blackpool!) bingo, cookery events, gallery visits and that's just for starters!
